Free Tree Giveaway

The Park in the City Committee has prioritized engaging residents with an opportunity to do their part in enhancing the urban canopy. Funding has been provided to give away 500 native trees during the Mother Earth Day event starting at 11 am. Tree sizes will range from 1 to 3 gallons. Trees are reserved for City of Niagara Falls residents only and are limited to one per property. Trees will be given out on a first-come, first-serve basis. Photo identification will be requested.

Tree Planting Event

A tree planting session will start at 11 am beside the Firemen's Park Amphitheatre to complement the various environmental activities. Twenty native tree species will be planted. Limited volunteer opportunities are available for this session.

Youth Activities

Youth activities provided by Heartland Forest, the Mayor's Youth Advisory Committee, and the Niagara Falls Public Library will occur throughout the day. Activities are geared towards those ages two and over, including Niagara Falls StoryWalk, crafts, face painting, a scavenger hunt, a rideable kids' train and more!

Environmental and Wellness Demonstrations

Interactive environmental and wellness demonstrations will start at 10 am and run every half hour until 3:30 pm. All demonstrations will last between 20 to 30 minutes and will include the following:
